BP Theatre

A sleek balance of functionality and style, the BP Theatre has very comfortable fixed tiered seating for 323 people, plus a raised stage with lectern and impressive Sony 4K Digital Projector and cinema-style screen. A control room provides access to state-of-the-art audio visual equipment.

Included in the hire of the BP Theatre is use of the East Foyer, an elegant curved space suitable for registration, refreshments, displays, branding and cloakroom, with 248m² of space which can accommodate between 8-10 exhibition stands.

All delegates can be served a standing lunch or drinks reception here for 330, and up to 150 people can enjoy a seated meal. A 'Green Room' is provided for speakers and VIPs which has easy access to the main stage.

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The Hugh & Catherine Stevenson Theatre

With an intimate feel, The Hugh and Catherine Stevenson Theatre is an elegant auditorium with fixed, tiered seating for 142 delegates. It is fully equipped with a screen, HD projector, lectern, two translation booths and an audio-visual control room fully fitted out with state-of-theart equipment.

Included in the hire of the Stevenson Theatre is the use of the West Foyer, an elegant curved space suitable for registration, refreshments, displays, branding and cloakroom, with 248m² of space which can accommodate between 8-10 exhibition stands.

All delegates can be served a standing lunch or drinks reception here for 330, and up to 150 people can enjoy a seated meal. A 'Green Room' is provided for speakers and VIPs which has easy access to the main stage.

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East & West Foyers

Sleek and stylish, The East and West Foyers continue the cool, elegant design of the impressive Great Court. Constructed from the same elegant limestone elements, the curved spaces are flowingly co-joined and offer a clean, sophisticated feel in which to impress guests or delegates.

The Foyers are used in conjunction with the BP and Stevenson Theatres respectively, but can also be hired independently for receptions, dinners or as an exhibition space. Indeed, they provide a welcome 'blank canvas' for organisers wishing to brand the space or to exhibit products and professional displays with elegance and style.

The large open space of the foyers are also excellent as a venue for a seated dinner for up to 150 people or a reception for up to 330 in each Foyer or 300 for dinner and 600 for a reception when combined. Each foyer has ample space for registration and cloakroom facilities.

Both the East and West Foyers have wheelchair access and are perfect for:

Meeting Rooms

From inspired brainstorming sessions, to accessible breakout spaces, the Museum has three versatile meeting rooms that can be utilised in a variety of ways.

The Raymond and Beverly Sackler Rooms can be used as one large space, or separately with a sound proof temporary partition in place. Up to 90 delegates can be accommodated theatrestyle when the rooms are combined, or 45 in each room separately. Classroom-style works well, as does cabaret-style in the two rooms together for up to 45 delegates.

The nearby Claus Moser Room can accommodate up to 35 theatre-style, or 18 as a boardroom. Moreover the room is fitted with audio-visual equipment.
